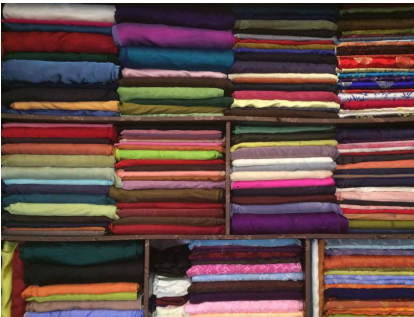


Shopping in Hue
